“SRB's performance was excellent and we had no issues during the countdown,” said Paul Gutierrez, USA’s Associate Program Manager for the Solid Rocket Booster Element. “This was the first flight of our upgraded IEA and our new Command Receiver Decoder. Both appeared to perform flawlessly.”

Gutierrez continued, “The recovery ship's have done preliminary above and below water assessments and results appear nominal. The SRBs should arrive back at the Hangar Friday afternoon.”
